

- Start procedure





- Manages Time Penalties





# THE OFFICIATING PROCESS

- How is an incident review initiated?
- 1. Corner Marshal report to race control
- 2. F4 Series Race official observation
- 3. Protest is filed by a competitor
- You may not leave track without Stewards consent if you are part of an incident review.






- Issue the penalty

































- Traffic patterns






























- Do not back up. • 40 MPH speed limit.

- Bump Drafting/Pushing • Brake Check. • Track Limits.









- Abort Lights










Penalty for doing practice starts outside designated area.



# Red lights - Illuminate in 1 second intervals Turn off between 1 and 5 seconds









