

Driver Licenses:

Minor Drivers holding a SCCA Pro competition license or SCCA Pro Provisional Competition license can compete for Championship points. Issuance of FIA Superlicense points are subject to FIA rules and regulations. No Minors under the age of 15 will be permitted to run this event per Indianapolis Motor Speedway Regulations.

Radio Frequency:

All teams are required to monitor the Race Control Frequency –

466.3875 DPL 664

All teams are required to submit their team frequencies to the series.

Transponders: All F4US cars are required to have a working transponder mounted in factory location. Please register your transponder numbers before the event with Steve Oseth – soseth@sccapro.com or CherriLea Roduner – croduner@sccapro.com.

Video Cameras:

All F4US cars must have operable video cameras located in the stock position on the left side of the roll bar. All cars must submit video cards to tech within 30 minutes of the end of that session. SEE Rules Clarification # 0005 for complete procedure description.

Starting Light Systems / Standing Start Practice:

Standing start practice will be available during Friday practice sessions. The lights will be located in the last pit stall before pit exit. Drivers must complete at least two observed practice starts prior to qualifying.

Golf Carts:

Commercial Liability Insurance: Documentation from your Insurance Carrier that you have Commercial Liability Coverage for your pit vehicle, golf cart (owned or rented) and to obtain your PIT VEHICLE PASS, must be provided to IMS. A full explanation of this requirement and process was sent to you in the Golf Cart Memo dated May 16. Please take time to review the information carefully and follow the instructions. Included will be numbers to call at IMS on any questions. **SVRA** has eased this process by creating an Insurance Coverage Program to handle this IMS requirement. This program is available for \$65 dollars by contacting Kathy (kathy@svra.com). Any Pit Support Vehicle found without this pass will be parked for the duration of the event by the Speedway.

NOTE

Please remember that not complying with the technical prescriptions will expose the product to excessive levels of mechanical stress, which could effect the integrity of the product.

To avoid any damage to the tyres caused by air leaks, we recommend the following:

- use metal valves bodies instead of rubber ones;
- check the fixing of the valves and their seal frequently;
- check the valve core;
- use metal valve caps with integral rubber o-ring seal.

Roll Bar Cover:

All teams are advised to specify the team name and car number inside of the roll bar cover should it be lost during an incident or while the car is being recovered.

Driver/Crew Attire:

All team members including the driver are expected to be in complaint F4 team apparel when at the track. Any teams in violation of this are subject to monetary and competition penalties.

Parc Fermé: Teams are reminded that after qualifying and all races, Parc Fermé will commence at

the sessions checkered flag. Cars entering pit lane after the checkered flag cannot stop

in pit lane and must report immediately to impound.

Flags: SCCA Pro Racing flagging rules will apply to all official sessions.

Party: SVRA will be hosting a Welcome Reception (heavy hors de'oeuvres and a cash bar) on

the Plaza at the completion of Saturday's on-track activities. Each driver will be given 2 tickets to this event and additional tickets may be purchased at Registration for \$30 each. Participants will be able to walk out on the "bricks" and will have access to the

IMS Podium for photo opportunities during the evening.
