Articles 48.3 & 48.4 are hereby amended to the following:

- 48.3 Video cards of all impounded cars must be removed by one team member, the video content may be copied to a laptop while in the impound area, and the card must be turned in to the Drop Off box immediately after. Competitors are required to submit video cards to the Stewards of the meet within 15 minutes of the end of each session. If there is an issue with the video content, the team member must notify an SCCA tech official or steward immediately. Teams are not allowed to edit, manipulate, or delete any video content prior to submitting their card until Parc Fermé has been lifted.
- 48.4 For cars not in impound, one team member must remove video card from camera while in Parc Fermé, the video content may be copied to a laptop while in the Parc Fermé area, and immediately turn the video card into the Drop Off box. Competitors are required to submit video cards to the Stewards of the meet within 15 minutes of the end of each session. If there is an issue with the video content, the team member must notify an SCCA tech official or steward immediately. Teams are not allowed to edit, manipulate, or delete any video content prior to submitting their card until Parc Fermé has been lifted.
