- This event is closed to the public.
- All teams are required to submit a list of essential personnel who will be attending the event. Series credentials are required for all attendees. This list is due to SCCA Pro Racing no later than September 21.
- All participants are required to stop at registration and sign all provided waivers at registration prior to entrance to the facility.
- <u>*Minors, if a parent or guardian will not be attending the race with you, you MUST fill out the Sebring COVID Minor</u> <u>Waiver and have it notarized prior to your arrival.</u>
- Temperatures will be taken at the entrance gate. Those showing a temperature greater than 100.1 degrees Fahrenheit will be denied access to the facility. Each time you enter the facility, your temperature must be taken.
- Masks or face coverings will be required in all areas with the exception of the following locations: personal vehicles and under team awning if less than 5 people are gathered.
- This is an evolving environment and as changes occur, the information will be communicated to the best of our ability via official channels and the track PA.
- Any person who attends this event is required to notify SCCA Pro Racing of any diagnosis of COVID-19 for up to 14 days after leaving the track.






PADDOCK MAPS








Load-In: Beginning at 12:00 pm, an SCCA official will direct you to load in to the facility in the following order.
