Post-Race Procedures

ANYONE ATTENDING VICTORY CIRCLE CELEBRATIONS WILL NEED TO WEAR A MASK.

Anyone who does not will be asked to leave. Drivers will receive series branded masks for trophy presentation.

Interviews

- At the conclusion of the cool down lap, all cars will enter pitlane.
- The winning car will go straight to the Road America victory circle stage located behind Start Finish Line
- P2 and P3 finishers in each class and other racers pertinent to the race narrative (Race Control will announce) will take their cars to the outside of victory circle. Drivers will leave their helmets and equipment with the car and immediately go to the stage. A member from the driver's team will drive the car and equipment immediately back tech.
- The balance of the field will return to the Parc Fermé area and observe Parc Fermé procedures.
- Winning driver will do his/her celebration, then stand by the car to wait for interview (take off equipment and leave in car).
- Videographer will interview the winning driver by his/her respective car in the winner's circle.
- After the winning driver completes his/her interview, proceed to the podium and maintain 6-feet distancing. Masks WILL be worn on the podium, SCCA Pro Racing will provide one if you do not have your own branded one.
- Interviews will be used for post-race notes and quotes, eliminating multiple contacts with the same driver.
- There will NOT be post-race media conferences. Media will reach out to drivers as needed.
- Master Class winners will be included in Victory Lane activities, if applicable.

Podium

- "No contact" trophy presentations. This means drivers will pick up their own trophy on the trophy table before going up to the stage. There will NOT be trophy presenters.
- Drivers are to remain separated as the podium steps will be placed further apart. Please refrain from physically congratulating one another, including, but not limited to, high fives, hugs, fist bumps, etc. Elbow bumps are fine.
- John Fippin will conduct a SHORT interview with each driver on the podium. MASKS MUST BE WORN.
- Donna will present a hat for you to wear onto the podium
- A line of hats will be on your podium step. We WILL do the hat dance for this race
- (NEW) All used hats will be placed in the individual baskets located behind the podium steps
- You can collect your hats from the basket at the end of the podium celebrations. Baskets will be sanitized between podiums.
- Photos will be taken of the drivers on the podium with masks, provided hat, and trophy.
- Sparkling grape juice will be provided for you to enjoy at your paddock. No spraying on the podium.
- The team of winning driver will need to take the car directly back to tech after final photo.
- Photographers must be 6 ft from podium and 6 ft from each other.
- Family and team members need to be 6 ft behind photographers and social distance amongst each other.
- ANYONE ATTENDING VICTORY CIRCLE MUST BE WEARING A MASK, otherwise you will be asked to leave.
- REMEMBER: we only have 10 minutes to get this done, and only 5-7 minutes to get interviews in before the next group takes the track, so we need to be just as speedy off track as we are on the track.
