Subject: Video Cards & Return Policy

Starting at the next event at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course, teams must ensure that the on-board camera is in working order and cards are turned in timely. Due to previous event issues, there will be escalating fines for teams, starting with \$100, for non-compliance.

Cards used in races will be retained by the series until the next event. For example, Mid-Ohio cards will be available for pick up at the Brainerd event. Please plan accordingly and be sure to being enough video cards for each car.

The following replaces Article 46.8 of 2021 F4 U.S. Championship Sporting Regulations.

46.8 Turn In & Pick Up

Drop Off boxes for video cards will be at the Championship trailer. Cards must be placed in slot corresponding to car number within 15 minutes after each official session.



Announcements will be made via official channels when cards are available for pick up after testing, practice, and qualifying sessions. Pick Up boxes will be available at the Championship trailer. Teams can expect to pick up cards for race sessions at the next event.
