Re: F4 U.S. Rounds 4 & 5 Clarification

Date: June 17, 2021

The F4 U.S. Championship consulted with the FIA, to confirm we were interpreting Article 6.4 correctly regarding Rounds 4 & 5. The Single Seater Department confirmed that we made the correct decision.

All laps of Round 4 were completed behind the safety car, and therefore no points were issued.

Because we only completed 16 minutes of racing in total for Round 5, this falls below the 75% threshold required for a 30-minute race, and therefore half points were issued.

The 2021 F4 U.S. Championship Driver and Team Points standing emailed on Monday, June 7, and linked below, will stand as final:

- F4 U.S. Championship Driver Point Standings After Road America
- F4 U.S. Championship Team Point Standings After Road America

The Championship continues to have internal discussions and make changes to improve the racing experiences for our drivers. The change to a single-file start for F4 Round 6 was to allow drivers an opportunity to settle in to a rhythm for the race.

We understand that many F4 drivers are competing in cars for the first time, and we will continue to make changes to increase the learning curve for these young drivers.
