Subject: Multiple Rule Clarifications / Updates

Article 26.3.j: It has come to our attention that HPD and Mountune sometimes receive a Wix oil filter (P/N: 51085) in lieu of the NAPA Gold oil filter specified in the rules. Both filters are identical in design and performance. Therefore, correct Article 26.3.j to read as follows;

"The only engine oil filters permitted are; NAPA Gold (P/N: 1085) and Wix (P/N: 51085) . No exterior coverings are permitted on the filter."

Article 26.3: Add a section at end of this article to allow auxiliary cooling devices to be used when a car is off-track.

"s) Auxiliary cooling systems, such as fans, blowers, etc. may be used to cool down vehicle components while a car is off-track. Such as when the car is in pit lane, traveling through the paddock, or sitting in parc ferme. Any such system shall be battery operated. Any such system must be removed before the car is weighed during technical inspection. "
