Updated track limits procedures from the Race Director:

Track Limits are defined in Article 19.3 of the 2021 F4 US Championship Sorting Regulations.

A driver will be judged to have left the track if no part of the car remains in contact with the track.

Qualifying:

During qualifying, drivers who are reported as exceeding track limits by a Judge of Fact will have that lap time disallowed by Timing. Drivers will not get a warning for exceeding track limits.

Races 1 & 2:

During both races, any track limit violation reports from a Judge of Fact will be referred to the Stewards.

Should a car leave the track, the driver may re-join, however this may only be done when it is safe to do so and without gaining any advantage either in car positions or time.
