The Stewards, having received a report from the Series Manager (22-NOLA-8), and having examined photographic evidence, and having summoned and heard from driver Lochie Hughes and team representative Jay Howard, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No/Driver	No. 6 – Lochie Hughes
Competitor	Jay Howard Driver Development

Session	Race 1
Facts	The driver of the No. 6 – Lochie Hughes – appeared on the post-race podium without the series-required patches on his uniform.
Offence	Breach of Article 20.10 of the Sporting Regulations
Decision	The Stewards find that the competitor was in breach of Article 20.10. The competitor is issued a reprimand, and will forfeit any prize money earned in this competition.
Reason	The Series Manager provided a statement to the Stewards, stating that the driver of the No. 6 car appeared on the post-race podium, and provided pictures of the competitor on the podium without the series-required uniform logos. The Sporting Regulations stipulate that the first “uniform offence” will trigger a reprimand, with further occurrences during the season triggering a \$500 fine. It is also stipulated that any violation of the policy triggers the loss of any prize money awarded from that competition.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards in accordance with Article 16.2 of the Sporting Regulations, except where the penalties are not susceptible to appeal (Articles 16.1.4.d, 16.2.2.e and 16.2.5 of the Sporting Regulations), within the applicable time limits.
