The Stewards, having a request from the Race Director to investigate reported contact between the Nos. 3 and 6 car during F4 Practice, and having examined video evidence, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

<b>No/Driver</b>	No. 3 Michael Boyiadzis
<b>Competitor</b>	Jay Howard Driver Development
<b>Time</b>	15:40
<b>Session</b>	F4 Practice
<b>Facts</b>	There was no useable video on the card from Practice 1. There was one file of cars sitting on the Pre-Grid, and several other files of sessions at Mid-Ohio.
<b>Offence</b>	Breach of Article 26.9, 46.1 and 46.2 of the Sporting Regulations
<b>Decision</b>	The Stewards issue a fine of \$100, as this is the first recorded violation of the rule during this season. Further violations have escalating penalties.
<b>Reason</b>	Article 26.9 requires working video during all on-track sessions. Article 46 specifically requires that each car has working video on the card delivered to the drop box, and that cards are cleared of all files at the beginning of each session. The team has not met these requirement.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards in accordance with Article 16.2 of the Sporting Regulations, except where the penalties are not susceptible to appeal (Articles 16.1.4.d, 16.2.2.e and 16.2.5 of the Sporting Regulations), within the applicable time limits.
